WHY NEW FRONTIERS CAMP?

There is something about getting away from the usual routine that helps us better connect with God and others. Camp allows students to spend a week free from distractions of the world to focus on building their relationship with God or be introduced to a relationship with God.

WHO'S GOING?

This event is open to all incoming 6th-8th students and EON leaders. Parent leaders are welcome, and we have ten available parent spots, but priority for additional leader spots go to our current EON leaders. All leaders will be required to pass a background check.

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE ACTIVITIES?

The activities include zip lining, caving, ropes course, canoeing, a giant swing, and a climbing wall.

HOW DO I SIGN UP?

Sign up online at experiencecc.com/summer-camps. Registration is open, and the deadline for registration is July 15th. We only have 120 spots available, so sign up ASAP! There is a deposit of \$75 due by June 15th. If you need help with finance, please email eon@experiencecc.com as we don't want the amount to deter you from letting your student go to camp!

WHAT IS ROOMING LIKE?

Students will be in cabins with their grade level and the same gender, with at least two adult leaders in each cabin. There will be a very strict policy of not going into an opposite gender's cabin.

If a student is in violation of that rule (or otherwise loses the privilege of being at the camp), a parent will be responsible for coming to pick up the student to take them home.

Packing List

Students are limited to one suitcase / duffle bag + carry on or backpack. Please pack for 5 days and 4 nights.

WHAT TO BRING

- Sweatshirt or Jacket
- Raincoat
- Secure, Closed-toe shoes
- Flip flops for shower
- Bug repellent & Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Baseball cap or hat (for sun)
- Clothes you can get dirty, that can potentially get muddy and ripped (for caving)
- Bathing suit (Modest, no bikinis or speedos)
- Extra pair of shoes, appropriate shoes for caving, appropriate shoes for canoeing
- Sleeping bag, Pillow
- Towel & Toiletries
- Bible, pen, pencil
- Medications labeled with name
- Two garbage bags (for dirty clothes)
- Water bottle (we recommend 2!)
- Snack money (T-shirts cost \$10 each, candy and soda \$1 each)
- Long pants/Long sleeves for caving

EON Summer Camp Rules

1. Respect leaders, New Frontiers team, other students, and yourself.
2. No guys in girl's rooms and vice versa.
3. Alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and weapons are prohibited.
4. Everyone must be in their rooms by the designated "In Room Time."
5. Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.
6. Respect the New Frontiers property.

- Sagging Pants
- Bikinis
- Miniskirts
- Spaghetti straps
- Low-cut tops
- Yoga pants (can wear if covered by long shirt)
- Muscle shirts/cut shirts
- Clothing with graphics or words that do not honor Jesus
- Phones will be taken up during camp, students will have the opportunity to contact family as needed.
